FREE MINISTRY PROGRAMS

FREE - But you get what you pay for which means limited resources and infrequent therapy in short bursts.

WORK FOR IT - Many of these programs require that you work a full-time job for them while in treatment. This means you're out of pocket and actual treatment opportunities are limited.

DISCIPLE DEMAND - Many free faith-based programs require you to believe in what they believe in, in order to heal from addiction.

LESS OVERSIGHT - Free ministry programs aren't held to the same standards and state licensure requirements that treatment centers are. They make their own rules - and that can be dangerous.

PASTORAL ADDICTION TREATMENT

AFFORDABLE - Unlike luxury treatment programs, residential pastoral treatment is often reasonably priced, offers healthy meals and tidy accommodations.

YOUR ONLY JOB IS TO HEAL - The focus is on your addiction treatment, not if you're making enough to cover room and board.

DISCIPLESHIP NOT REQUIRED - Most pastoral treatment centers hope you will follow their teachings but the focus is on healing, not forcing beliefs on you.

REGULATORY OVERSIGHT - A reputable biblical addiction treatment center is held to state standards for treatment. This ensures safety, cleanliness and security of the treatment environment.
